



## Fact Sheet

City Reach is our summer mission trip but it is more than a mission trip. This experience will give students and leaders a vision of what can be accomplished through the love of Jesus Christ. City Reach is a laboratory for ministry, empowering students and leaders for serving and impacting their local church.

City Reach provides a mission experience combined with a youth conference, by which Christian students can grow spiritually, and be actively involved in helping start, build up, and establish indigenous churches. Students will spend the week serving the community and the local church with approximately 250 other students. It is our hope that students get a first hand look at what it is like to put others first, to show the love of Christ through service, and to connect with God on this 9 day journey. It is our desire to see God radically change their outlook on life, their attitude about life, and their desires for the future.

### Destination and Dates

CityReach 2012 has major things in store! We will be heading to Mississauga, Canada near Toronto! CityReach is really excited to announce that we will be partnering with Pastor David Smith and The Vine Church in Mississauga, Ontario. The trip will be from June 7-16.

### Service Projects

Students will have the choice of servicing in one of six different areas.

- Back Yard Bible Clubs
- Totally Free Car Wash
- Construction
- Random Acts of Kindness
- Blitz [getting the gospel presentation into hands]
- Food Bank

### Group Activity

We will be get the chance to see Niagara Falls and/or Toronto. This will be an exciting adventurous time for our group.

### Cost

**CityReach :: \$425 per student** [this will cover everything while in Canada]  
**Passport Card :: \$55** [16 & older] **\$40** [15 & under] [the may be additional fees]  
Each student is asked to pay for one meal to and from Canada.

## Payments

first deposit:               \*\$125 due January 25, 2012 [this is a non-refundable deposit]  
second payment:           \$100 is due February 26, 2012  
third payment:             \$100 is due March 25, 2012  
fourth payment             \$100 is due April 29, 2012  
\*the first payment is personal out-of-pocket expense. The fund raisers will go toward the remainder.

## Passport and Passport Card Requirements

- \* EVERYONE 18 and older MUST have a Passport or Passport Card
- \* EVERYONE 17 and under MUST have either
  - a Passport or Passport Card; OR
  - driver's license and notarized, original birth certificate
  - all minors MUST have a written, notarized affidavit
  
- \* For ease of travel, CityReach recommends a Passport or Passport Card.

## Other Requirements

The group should be prepared to present a letter on organizational letterhead with the following information:

- The name of the group and supervising adult,
- A list of the children on the trip, and the primary address, phone number, date of birth, place of birth, and name of at least one parent or legal guardian for each child,
- A written and signed statement of the supervising adult certifying that he or she has obtained parental or legal guardian consent for each participating child.
